

The Great Belbroughton Bake Off Rules 2017



Entries should be delivered to the Church Hall between 4.00 – 6.00 pm on Friday 29 September or between 8.00 - 9.30 am on Saturday 30 September. Judging will begin at 10.30 am and photos of the cakes and results will be on display shortly after. Formal announcement of the results will be at 122 noon on Sunday 1st October when Scarecrow winners will also be announced.

Categories & Prize Money:

- Fables & Fairy Tales Show Stopper £50
- Victoria Sandwich £20
- Chocolate Cake £20
- Cake containing a vegetable £20
- 12 identical fairy cakes £20

Children 11 and under only:

- 12 fairy cakes £20
- 12 pieces of chocolate fridge cake (7cm x 7cm) £20

Competition Rules

1. The competition is open to all.
2. Contestants may enter only one item per category but may enter more than one category.
3. There is no cost to enter. All entries are donations to Belbroughton Scarecrow Festival.
4. All baked goods must be fully baked and complete.
5. All entries should be prepared and cooked in hygienic conditions.
6. No commercial or box mixes may be used.
7. Entries can be delivered on any hygienic surface eg plate, board etc but items for return must be clearly labelled with contact information.
8. Entries should be labelled as to which category they are competing in.
9. Nuts. If your entry contains nuts please make this clear on the entry form.
10. Each entry should be accompanied by a completed entry form which is available via the website, FB page or completed on delivery.

Upon completion of the judging, the entries will be made available for use and sale in the Church Hall Tearoom. All funds raised will be donated to Belbroughton Scarecrow Festival and distributed to its good causes.

The results will be displayed in the Church Hall and formally announced on the Main Stage at 12 noon on Sunday 1st October
